



2024 Registration Information

Moorebank Sports Soccer Club would like to extend a warm welcome to all new and returning players for the 2024 season. Please carefully read the following information, which explains how you can register to play soccer with our Club in 2024.

*****All registrations are completed online via www.playfootball.com.au*****

Registrations for U18, U21, Premier League and Women's M-League will open 6th January.

All other age groups will open 15th January.

Grading session dates are available on the What On page or on our Facebook and Instagram pages.

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER

The Active Kids program provides \$50 vouchers for parents, guardians and carers of *school-enrolled* children to use towards sport and active recreation costs. From 1st February 2024, the voucher will only be available to those eligible.

To apply for an Active Kids Voucher to offset your fees, go to <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-active-kids-voucher>

This should be completed prior to commencing the Play Football registration as the details will be required to be entered on the registration form.

Registration Fees

Registration fees for the 2024 season are as follows:

Registration fees include:

- Playing jersey and training jersey
- one pair of shorts,
- two pairs of socks,
- training ball,
- FFA, FNSW and SDSFA or MFA fees,
- referee and game leader fees; and
- sports insurance.



Payments

Payment of registration fees is not compulsory prior to the grading session; however, you must have a pending registration in the registration system before being able to participate in grading sessions. If you are not paying your fees at this point, please submit your registration using the “pay later” option.

There are three methods of paying for registrations –

1. On-line within Play Football at the time of registration or later.
2. After Pay will be accessible at <https://moorebanksoccer.square.site>. Note that merchant fees are included in the price. Purchase the product that matches the age the player is turning in 2024, or what team they are in (for U18, U21, Premier League or M-League) and whether or not an active kids voucher was redeemed in Play Football

New Players – Identification

All new players to MSC or any player who has not played with MSC within the last three years will be required to present identification. This is to be a birth certificate, passport, drivers licence or other suitable document showing a photo of the participant and their birth date. This can be done in person at the registration help day or by emailing a photo or scan of the document to registrar@moorebanksoccer.com.au.

Registration Late Fee

From the 18th March 2024, \$50 will be added to the registration fee for late registrations.

Family Discount

A family discount is available for 3 or more players in an immediate family where all fees are paid before 18 March 2024. The discount will be half the out of pocket expense for the cheapest registration fee, maximum of 1 discount per family.

Team Officials – Coaches and Managers

All team officials must register online at <https://www.playfootball.com.au/> as soon as possible after 15 January 2024 and before participating in team training/management activities.

All team officials **MUST** complete, or already have, a Working with Children Check prior to registration and provide the WWCC number when registering – refer to the <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-for-a-working-with-children-check> or the attached for more information. Your registration will be declined if you do not have a valid check.



Photo Upload Guidelines

Photos uploaded into Play Football must be in the following format or your registration will not be approved. They must be less than 12 months old. Please be aware that the photo file size is restricted when uploading to Play Football.



Deregistration

Should a player wish to withdraw from MSC, they should request de-registration in their Play Football account. An email will be sent to the MSC Registrar for submission. The request is then approved by SDSFA. The player is not eligible to register for a new club until SDSFA have approved the request.

Players or parents are encouraged to communicate with their team's coach, manager or appropriate age co-ordinator so that the club is aware of the deregistration.



Refunds

Refunds may be paid on deregistration.

MSSC Inc. Terms and Conditions of Registration

The following terms and conditions are agreed when registering in Play Football:

I, hereby apply to register myself, or the named minor (if applicable) with Moorebank Sports Soccer Club Inc (MSSC). I agree, in either case to be bound by the MSSC Association Rules and Southern Districts Soccer Football Association Inc. (SDSFA) By-laws and Constitution. Furthermore, I agree to the following Terms and Conditions of registration and acknowledge that failure to adhere to these may result in my registration being cancelled.

I declare that I, or the named minor (if applicable):

1. Is not under suspension or has any unresolved matters with any organisation.
2. Is not contracted or signed with any other Club this season.
3. Is duly qualified to register and act in the above capacity in accordance with the SDSFA Inc. By-laws.
4. Is not an ineligible person as defined by the SDSFA By-laws, and agree that any false information provided will incur an automatic five (5) year ban from participating in any SDSFA activity.
5. Has no monies, dues or property owing to any other Club or Association or their agent.
6. Has completed this registration truthfully and all details are correct
7. Will not hold MSSC responsible for any injury sustained during the course of traveling to or from or participating in any competition, trial, social game or training session whilst representing MSSC.
8. Will be responsible for payment of all fines attributed to me as a player, official or spectator which are imposed by SDSFA in line with those listed in the By Laws.



9. Will be equally responsible for payment of fines attributed to the team I am associated with, which are imposed by SDSFA in line with those listed in the By Laws.
10. Understand that failure to pay fines above (8.) (9.), may result in my temporary suspension from participating in the game until paid.
11. Have read, understand and will abide by all Football NSW Policies, including but not limited to those relating to behaviour, alcohol and smoking at all venues.
12. Will not make any statement in public, including on social media; that is disparaging or derogatory of a Match Official, opposition team or Player, any Official or Administrator of the game.
13. Will take due care of all equipment that is the property of MSSC.
14. Will abide by guidelines that relate to the care and proper use of MSSC playing jerseys.
15. Will agree to support MSSC by making myself available to assist with canteen and other volunteer duties when rostered.
16. Will authorize the publication of any photography or video taken for or during the period of registration for the use of promoting or advertising, unless I notify MSSC of my desire to not permit any published photos at the time of registration.
17. Understand that information collected herein is for the use of MSSC and SDSFA only and will not be used for any other purpose unless I agree otherwise.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK ALL TEAMS WITH PLAYERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

Football NSW requires all adults volunteering to assist with teams that contain players under the age of 18yrs old to obtain a Working with Children Check (WWC).

The WWC legislation provides exemptions from the requirement to obtain a WWC Number for certain categories of individuals, including:

1. Volunteer parents or close relatives coaching or managing their own child's or close relative's team;
2. Referees; and
3. Persons aged under 18 years of age.

Football NSW recognising that the WWC are only part of an organisation's tools for promoting a child safe environment, the Board of Football NSW was concerned that these exemptions, particularly the first two, meant that a significant and important portion of the membership was not being subjected to the WWC.

Accordingly, under their Working with Children Check Policy, the following require a WWC Number as a condition of registration:

1. Volunteer parents or close relatives coaching or managing their own child's or close relative's team;
2. Referees
3. All workers and volunteers involved in any official club, association etc. event or activity that involves over-night stays, tours or camps involving overnight accommodation.

All persons aged under 18 years of age, remain exempt.

How to Apply for a Working with Children Check

1. Complete the online application form.
2. Take your email receipt, your proof of identity documents and fee (if applicable) to a Service NSW Centre.
3. WWC Screening will then commence.
4. Give your APP/WWC Number to your club, association, referee branch, futsal centre to verify your details and clearance in the online verification system.

Once the check is completed you will receive an APP number that will begin with WWC. Please forward the APP/WWC number along with your surname, date of birth & team name to Stephanie Wilcox at registrar@moorebanksoccer.com.au. This number will be required to be entered into your Play Football registration for team officials.

If you have already have a current WWC number, please forward to details to the above email address. All information and outcomes will be treated in the strictest confidence.
