Submitting a Working with Children (WWCC) Exemption Request

All Game Leaders are required to submit an exemption for the working with children check. This is a mandatory requirement for all official roles in the play football system when the officials are either under the age of 18years old at the time of registration or who are coaching and managing teams where all players are over the age of 18years old are required to submit a WWCC exemption request. **This exemption must be completed during the registration process.**

Please complete the following steps in the registration process.

1. Select product and start the registration process.
2. When you get to the below screen, select No, I don't
