



General

1. Each year, players will receive a playing jersey to keep at the end of the season.
2. Players will also provide a second jersey to be worn for training and as an alternative playing jersey. This jersey will usually be designed in the opposite colours to the usual playing jersey.
3. At the commencement of each season, each team Coach or Manager will be provided with a team kit comprising of:

4. Team coaches/managers are required to sign for the receipt of team kits in the presence of the Club's Equipment Officer.
5. Additional training equipment may be provided upon request to the Club's Equipment Officer.
6. Washing of bibs is the responsibility of the coach/manager during the season.
7. All team kits must be maintained in good condition, bibs washed and returned to the Club's Equipment Officer after the conclusion of the season at a designated time.
8. Team coaches/managers are responsible for maintaining team kits and may be required to meet the full cost of any damaged or missing equipment.

Player Kit

1. Players will be given, as part of their registration package, a playing jersey, an alternative jersey, shorts, two pairs of socks and a training ball, forming the player kit.
2. Players are required to have both their usual playing jersey and their alternative jersey at all games to ensure that the most appropriate jersey is worn by the entire team.
3. All player items will be distributed to coaches and managers at the same time as their kit bag.
4. Designated times will be allocated by the Equipment Officer to allow players to swap any items for incorrect sizing.
5. Training balls may be kept by the coach/manager to ensure balls are available for training sessions. These should be returned to the players at the end of the season.

Goalkeeper Kit

1. Each team will be issued with a goalkeeper kit including a jersey, shorts and socks.
2. This kit can be kept by the goalkeeper at the end of the season.

3. The coach/manager may choose to keep the kit in the kit bag in case that a substitute goalkeeper is required for a game.

Kit Items for Sale

1. Replacement items are available for sale in case of loss or damage.
2. Items for sale include jerseys, shorts, socks and balls.
